## POINTS TROPHIES

For a member to be eligible for Trophies, you must be "Financial" and wearing the Official Club Uniform.

To be eligible for points trophies you must have competed in 6 of the 9 qualifying events. Points are accumulated on handicap results i.e. 1 point for finishing 1st etc. Your best 6 results determine your overall final points tally with the lowest points total determined as the winner i.e. the perfect result would be 6 wins and 6 points.
